**Coordinator’s Report**

- In January – sent out RBS training flyers and 2 businesses requested those (Tobacco Mart, Belle’s BBQ = 12 employees)
- Sources of Strength – planning a community wide campaign funded by NKY ASAP
- Sources of Strength implemented at the Elementary level. Total of 15 across district attended a training.
- Checkpoints – MOUs completed by both schools (GCHS Officer Ervin, Williamstown Shelli Johnson) – Safe driving for parents and teens.
- Coalition involvement agreements – be sure to send those back to Launi
- Federal financial report – complete!
- DFC progress report – due in two weeks

**Community Assessments**

- Created survey similar to KIP survey since it wasn’t sent out in 2020. Launi reached out to principals to implement. One district denied, another agreed.
- Food distribution survey – we will be utilizing the food pantry as well as the Dinner Table Project families from Dry Ridge and Williamstown.
- Annual member update/coalition capacity survey – only 1/3 of those who filled out the Annual member Update went on to fill out the Coalition Capacity Survey.
  - Next Tuesday on Feb 9, community stakeholders and sector representatives will meet for a strategic action planning session that determines activities and funding for next 5 years. Will be



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using the coalition capacity survey to guide this conversation for strategic action planning session.

**New Business**

**Approval of Officer Changes for 501c3 Documents & Filings**

The position of Project Director was previously held by Nancy Howe until her retirement on September 15, 2020. As of September 16, 2020, the position has been filled by Danielle Haley. This change also makes Danielle Haley a Director of Champions for a Drug-Free Grant County Incorporated.

The position of Project Coordinator was previously held by Camille Croweak until her resignation on October 30, 2020. As of November 2, 2020, the position has been filled by Launi Gum. This change also makes Launi Gum a Director of Champions for a Drug-Free Grant County.

Previously, Kelly West (Coalition Chair/Non-Profit President) was listed as the Registered Agent. The Registered Agent will now be Launi Gum.

**Medical cannabis legislation** – Overview via NKY ASAP

- Opt-out rather than an opt-in
  - county can opt-out but the city can still allow medical cannabis, it just can't be grown, processed or dispensed.
- No age limit on use. Prescription has to be purchased by a parent or caregiver over 18, but can be used by any age.
- License fees and violation fees go to state while taxes would go to local. None of this tax is designated to be used for education.
- Managed by ABC (Alcoholic Beverage Control). Required to issue at least a *minimum* by 2022 @ 1 per developmental district.
- No restrictions on flavored products which goes against Best Practice.
- Coalition will be putting out a **position statement**. Launi will send the statement out to everyone so members can review and address concerns.
- Local coalitions address this individually or will NKY ASAP lead this effort? Waiting to hear back.
- Because it can be taxed and you need a prescription, thinking it MIGHT not be going through insurance companies (still needs to be confirmed).

**Agency Announcements**

Free 2-weeks NRT available until the end of May 2021 for Grant County residents at 3 Grant County Drugs locations (Williamstown, Dry Ridge, Crittenden).

Carley, Robin, Breanna expressed wanting more information on medical cannabis.
