- Advocacy: process of supporting a cause or proposal.
- Advocacy (CADCA): educate people about your position.
- Lobbying
 - Lobbying: influencing a lawmaker, executive agency or retirement system decision maker on a public policy matter.
 - Lobbying (CADCA): taking a specific position on a specific piece of legislation.
 - Lobbying MUST:
 - Amount of compensated time lobbying by week: Legislative lobbying: 5% / Executive agency lobbying: 25% / Retirement system lobbying: 25%
 - Receive compensation
 - Directly communicate to reportable person
