- Casey Baker-Romans (NKY Health) was recognized for her work in tobacco prevention and treatment during this workshop!
- Sources of Strength Saturday @ Sherman Elementary was cancelled due to low registration
  - Trying to change approach to get more interest in participation
- Provision of Elementary Vape Resources consistently across Grant County Schools elementary schools has transitioned into implementing an actual Elementary Vape Prevention Plan
- **Budget Overview**
  - DFC Budget Remaining FY10 (2025-2026): \$69,158.35
    - Working with Grant County Schools Finance Department to determine carryover amount from previous years
    - Handle With Care Project - \$2,971.20 investment created 90 leave behind bags for law enforcement when responding to Handle with Care calls that involve youth
      - Duffle bags without logos were used for all bags
      - Adult bags have first aid kits, prescription lock box/bag, prescription disposal pouch, naloxone
      - Middle School/High School bags have travel hygiene kits, Sources of Strength Wellness Plan, Sources of Strength Tap Into Strength bracelet, coloring book, colored pencils
      - Elementary bags have stuffed animal and fidget toys
      - NorthKey will continue providing these bags after coalition dissolves
  - DFC In-Kind Match Requirement Met:%26.75
  - Non DFC-Funding Balance: \$3,293.93
